
AutoCAD Raster Design

Training course outline

AutoCAD Raster Design is used to convert raster images into vectorised DWG™ objects that you can work on in AutoCAD. It offers a range of powerful tools for 'cleaning up' and enhancing the images.

AutoCAD Raster Design training teaches the use of the key features required to use the application effectively.



Course summary

Teaches how to use AutoCAD Raster Design to extend the value of scanned drawings and maps, aerial photos, satellite imagery and digital elevation models.

The techniques covered include the creation, insertion, modification and management of raster data. Sessions include:

- Inserting and creating images.
- Saving and exporting images.
- Correlating and rubbersheeting images.
- Enhancing the appearance of images.
- Editing images.
- Raster-to-vector conversion.

A basic working knowledge of AutoCAD is recommended but not essential.
